Here's how you can help:

Host a Product Drive: You can host your own product drive at your home, place of work, church, club, college, or other organization. Here are a few tips for hosting a drive:

- Create a **flier or a poster** that you can hang to advertise when and where product can be donated.
- Share the details of the drive on **social media**.
- If your drive will take place outside of your home, ask the organization where you can place **boxes or baskets to collect the product** and make sure to clearly mark the bin – this may inspire other donations!

Host a Packing Event: You can pack products on your own or with friends! Here are a few tips on packing products:

- Collect **individually wrapped product**.
- Create **reusable bags or purchase disposable paper bags** for products.
Instructions can be found on our website.
- Combine the **same product in each bag:**
 - 25 tampons, 7 pads, 20 liners (tampons at the bottom)
 - They can also include hand sanitizer and wipes
- Place finished bags in a **garbage bag or box for delivery**.
- The Period Collective can also **supply you with bags and product** if you would prefer to not to host a drive prior to packing.

Donate Funds for Supplies: We're grateful for any amount of monetary contributions we receive. Donations are used to purchase pads, tampons, and other products in bulk.
